St. Louis City Forestry is working to expand our tree canopy. Over the next 4 years, 3,200 street trees will be planted across 10 wards. Additionally, these trees will be watered! Thousands of existing street trees will also be pruned, all to enhance the City's canopy.

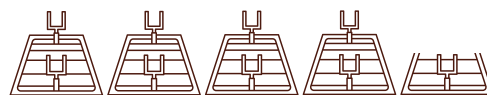

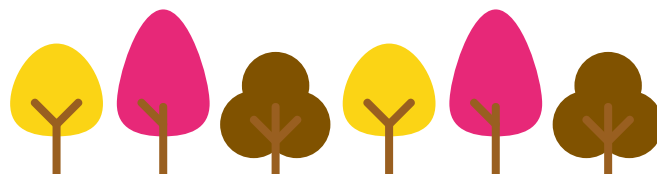
OTHER TREE NEWS...

- In addition to its terraced garden beds along De Tonty Ave, Greenhouse Ventures in Shaw has completed a surrounding tree inventory that will inform canopy enhancements along the highway embankment.
- In 2024 Tower Grove Park planted 595 new trees and shrubs, completing its commitment of planting over 1000 trees in 5 years. This increase in tree canopy added 70 new taxons to their inventory!
